Members of the council will receive an Honorarium for each advisory body meeting attended that will include the following:

- Federal Mileage Rate of .67 per mile traveled up to a maximum of 200 miles per round trip per meeting
- \$30.15 per hour for a maximum of two (2) hours per meeting for an estimated maximum number of 28 pilot project meetings
- Meetings will be on the second Thursday of each month from 3:00-5:00p.m.
